**FIFA WORLD CUP 2026™ MATCH SCHEDULE NOW COMPLETE FOR LOS ANGELES
FOLLOWING EUROPEAN PLAY-OFF QUALIFIERS**

The Los Angeles World Cup 2026 Host Committee is proud to welcome Bosnia and Herzegovina and Türkiye alongside Belgium, Iran, New Zealand, Paraguay, Switzerland and the United States Men's National Team for their group stage matches starting this June.



LOS ANGELES (April 1, 2026) – Following the final play-offs for the FIFA World Cup 2026™, the full tournament match schedule is now available and published on [FIFA.com](https://www.fifa.com)—marking a major milestone on the road to the biggest FIFA World Cup™ in history. Six teams earned places on March 31, 2026, as the global qualifying campaign ended after 899 matches across 937 days.

After thrilling victories in the European play-offs, Los Angeles will officially welcome Bosnia and Herzegovina, who will join Group B and play against Switzerland on June 18 and Türkiye, who will join Group D and play against the United States Men's National Team on June 25. The complete list of teams playing a Group Stage match in Los Angeles now includes Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iran, New Zealand, Paraguay, Switzerland, Türkiye, and the United States. All eight FIFA World Cup 2026 matches will be played at Los Angeles Stadium (SoFi Stadium) in Inglewood.

“We are proud to welcome Bosnia and Herzegovina and Türkiye to Los Angeles as part of an exciting lineup of Group Stage matches that also includes the U.S. Men’s National Team opening match,” said **Kathryn Schloessman, CEO of the Los Angeles World Cup 2026 Host Committee**. “With the final schedule now confirmed, we are focused on delivering an exceptional experience for the players, global fans, and our local communities. We look forward to hosting an incredible slate of matches featuring Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iran, New Zealand, Paraguay, Switzerland, Türkiye, and the United States, as we welcome fans from around the world to be part of this once-in-a-generation moment.”

The FIFA World Cup 2026™ will take place across 16 Host Cities in Canada, Mexico and the United States, and will be the first to feature 104 matches, delivering an unparalleled experience for fans both in-stadium and around the world, qualified national teams and global media. With the stage now set, fans can start making their plans to be there and witness history in the making. FIFA has announced the FIFA World Cup 2026™ [Last-Minute Sales Phase](#), the fourth and final official ticket sales phase, is now open. Beginning at 8AM PST on April 1, 2026, the general public will be able to purchase tickets on a first come, first served basis, and subject to availability at [FIFA.com/tickets](https://www.fifa.com/tickets). Fans will be able to immediately see the matches and categories for which tickets are available, select specific seats, proceed with the purchase, and receive confirmation once payment is completed. This sales window will remain open until the end of the competition, with more tickets made available on an ongoing basis (subject to availability), offering fans a final pathway to be part of history.

In addition, FIFA will reopen the official Resale/Exchange Marketplace for eligible ticket holders on Thursday, April 2, 2026, via [FIFA.com/tickets](https://www.fifa.com/tickets). This platform enables fans who can no longer attend matches to sell their tickets to other fans in a secure and authorized environment, safeguarding against invalid or unauthorized resale.
